1. Who Were the Three Stooges by Pam Pollack

* Three Stooges - Pollack

Pub. 2016 --- 112 pages

This picture biography shares the story of how three young boys from Brooklyn and Philadelphia became the Three Stooges, the screwball slapstick trio known for their eye-poking, head-bopping, pie-throwing zaniness.

2. The Vanderbeekers of 141st Street by Karina Yan Glaser

* Vanderbeekers - Glaser

Pub. 2018 --- 320 pages

Told that they will have to move out of their Harlem home just after Christmas, the five Vanderbeeker children, ages four to twelve, decide to change their reclusive landlord's mind.

3. The Boy at the Back of the Class by Onjali Rauf

* Boy at the Back - Rauf

Pub. 2020 --- 304 pages

When quiet, nine-year-old Ahmet arrives in their classroom, a boy and his friends fail to draw him out but try a new plan after learning he is a Syrian refugee.

4. Dungeon Academy: No Humans Allowed! by Madeleine Roux

* Dungeon Academy - Roux

Pub. 2021 --- 208 pages

When Zellidora "Zelli" Stormclash seeks answers to her true lineage, she embarks on a dangerous adventure joined by a vegan owlbear, a cowardly kobold, and a shapeshifting mimic in a world that holds no place for them.

5. The Unforgettable Logan Foster by Shawn Peters

* Unforgettable Logan Foster - Peters

Pub. 2022 --- 288 pages

Logan, an undersized twelve-year-old orphan with a photographic memory and no filter, discovers that his foster parents are superheroes in grave danger.

6. Tumble and Blue by Cassie Beasley

* Tumble and Blue - Beasley

Pub. 2018 --- 416 pages

When the red moon rises over the heart of the Okefenokee Swamp, legend says that the mysterious golden gator, Munch, will grant a great fate to the poor soul foolish enough to face him.

7. The Umbrella Maker's Son by Katrina Leno

* Umbrella Maker's Son - Leno

Pub. 2023 --- 384 pages

Oscar Buckle lives in a city where it's always raining. Oscar's father is an umbrella maker but while Buckle Umbrellas are strong, reliable, and high quality, they're expensive. Because of this, people are buying from the competitor instead, which is threatening Oscar's family's business.

8. *I Survived the Attacks of September 11th* (Graphic Novel) by Lauren Tarshis

Pub. 2021 --- 160 pages

When Lucas decides to skip school because he wants to discuss football with a firefighter friend of his father, he finds himself caught up in the terrorist attacks on New York City.

9. Hope in the Holler by Lisa Lewis Tyre

* Hope in the Holler - Tyre

Pub. 2018 --- 224 pages

Upon her mother's death, Wavie Conley, eleven, must go live with a scheming aunt in the Kentucky town her mother left behind.

10. Holes by Louis Sachar

* Holes - Sachar

Pub. 2000 --- 233 pages

As further evidence of his family's bad fortune, which is attributed to a curse, Stanley is sent to a terrible correctional camp in the Texas desert.
