

Coming soon! Mother's Day Rock Art Mural on the new South Fayette Township Library Patio

The South Fayette and Bridgeville Libraries are partnering with Selva Priya Sahadevan of Priya Arts to show love for all things related to Mothers; Mothers, Grandmothers, Aunts, Motherly caregivers, Mother Earth, Mother Nature, Motherland, Mother-tongue, etc.

This Mother's Day Art exhibit will be displayed on the South Fayette Township Library Patio. The exhibit will contain a mural decorated with painted rocks by both the students of Priya Arts and by the children of our community. Decorate the rock enclosed in this activity bag and it will be added to the display!

If you wish for your painted rock to be part of the exhibit, please return the decorated rock to the South Fayette Township Library by 4 pm on Wednesday May 5th. This will allow Ms. Nicole H. time to spray seal both sides of the rock to make the design weatherproof.



This activity bag contains a silver painted rock along with 3 pots of acrylic paint, q-tips and toothpicks to use as tools if desired. Children may decorate the rock anyway desired and are not restricted to these colors or tools.

After the paint has dried for several hours, additional details may be added with a permanent marker.

We suggest writing the artist's name on the reverse side of the rock.

The art exhibit will be on display from Mother's Day, May 9th through Friday May 14th.

Children may pick up their rocks Saturday May 15th and Sunday May 16th.

Decorate a flowerpot and grow a Zinnia at home!

This activity bag also contains: Clay pot, a dirt pellet, and Zinnia seeds. To paint your pot, you can use q-tips as paint brushes to paint a flower.



Or maybe use your finger to make two prints on the pot. After the paint has dried, use a permanent marker to turn your fingerprints into a bee, butterfly or whatever you like! Before you plant your seed, you will need to add water to your dirt pellet and let it soak for 15-20 minutes.



Fold a napkin or paper towel and place in the bottom of the pot, then add the wet soil pellet.

Lay the seed on top of the soil pellet and poke it down about ¼ inch and cover with soil.

Set pot in a sunny window. Every day, add a little water to keep the soil pellet damp. The plant should start growing in 1 - 2 weeks. Once the plant is about 2 inches high, you can transplant it outdoors.
